\$200,000 in Grants Available to Improve Colorado's Oral Health

Delta Dental of Colorado offers grants up to \$50,000 each to Colorado-based organizations and individuals with innovative approaches to improve oral health

To be considered grant proposals must:

- **Originate in Colorado** – Out-of-state applications will not be accepted.
- **Demonstrate innovation** – Delta Dental seeks to support the newest, untested, cutting edge ideas and approaches to improve oral health in Colorado.
- **Be impactful** – Funded ideas will advance the field of oral health in a meaningful way in Colorado.

Proposals can address any one of the many oral health challenges facing the state. These can include innovations that significantly improve the quality of care; new oral health related technologies; oral health literacy; dental practice efficiency; integrating oral health and overall health; and increasing focus to prevention and/or early intervention.
